He is a specialist of neuropsychiatry, subspecialist of social psychiatry, permanently employed at the Psychiatric Clinic, University Clinical Hospital Mostar, and currently Head of Department for Chronic Psychoses. He is a University Professor at the Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Health Studies and Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of Mostar, where he holds the position as head of several departments in the field of psychiatry and psychology. He studied at the Universities of Tuzla and Mostar, and also completed training programs in the Republic of Croatia, Slovenia and Italy. He is one of the most prolific scientists at the University of Mostar. He was involved in writing of nine books, five of which are university textbooks. He participated in many scientific conferences, symposia and congresses both home and abroad. Professor Babić is the author and co-author of over 100 professional and scientific articles published in domestic and foreign publications, of which 66 are in PubMed (16 CC). He is the head of multiple projects supported by the Federal Ministry of Education and Science and a participant in several international projects. He is the mentor of 8 doctoral dissertations, over 50 master's theses and around 150 final and graduate theses. He is the Vice-President of the Psychiatric Association of Bosnia-Herzegovina, and in the period 2013-2014 obtained President position. Professor Babić is the President of the Organizing Committee of the International Symposium Mostar's Psychiatric Saturday from 2003-2017, and the President of the Organizing Committee for Bosnia and Herzegovina at the 23rd Danube Symposium held in Mostar on 2008. He completed numerous trainings in the field of psychiatry: psychotraumatology, addiction, suicide, group psychoanalysis. He was born in Živinice on 1958, he is married and lives in Mostar with his wife and two children.
