Psychiatry and Mental Health: Dilemmas and Perspectives

He is Professor of Psychiatry at the at Psychiatry Department, School of Medicine at the Kocaeli University, Past Chair of the WPA Section on Education (2008 – 2014), Director of Community Mental Health Center of Kocaeli University (CMHC) and President of the Association for Community Mental Health Promotion (member of WFMH).

He had his medical training and psychiatric residency at Hacettepe University Ankara (1972 – 1982). He worked at different state hospitals, then as the Director of Mental Health Department at the Ministry of Health (1985 – 1991). He lead the Mental Health Program Development activities in close relation with WHO, took active part in the Project for the settlement and psychosocial support for the forced migration of, then called, Bulgarian Ethnic Turks (1989), had been the member of the Turkish delegation for World Health Assembly for six consecutive years (1988 – 1993), taken part in various WHO missions at Tanzania, Macedonia, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan also taken part at several workshops and training programs of WHO.

He was the founder of two different psychiatry departments at two different Universities, one in the Eastern part of Turkey (Inonu University), the other on the West where he is currently a Faculty (Kocaeli University).

After the devastating Marmara earthquake in 1999, lead CMHC mainly working on mental health awareness activities, locally and nationally (awarded a commendational certificate for the awareness training programs by a joint group of WHO and WFMH - 2004).

He contributed to several articles, book chapters and presentations at various national and international congresses, is the author of a book published by WHO-Euro: “Improving Mental Health in the Central Asian Republics” (2000) and is one of the editors and authors of the book “Teaching Psychiatry, Putting Theory into Practice” (2011).

He has served as Member of the Operational Committee of WPA Secretary for Education as well as a Chief of local Branch of the Psychiatric Association of Turkey and he is a member of the Turkish Social Psychiatric Association.
