Estimated number of participants at the course is **20 (no more than 25)**, and the course will be held on **English (no translation is provided)**, lasting **180 minutes** (excluding one refreshment break of half an hour).

The course is **free of charge for all selected participants** who registered and have paid the *Registration Fee for the Congress*, and each course participant will receive appropriate materials relating to course.

This Certificate is separate from the Certificate of Attendance at the IV Congress of Psychiatry of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Organizers will apply for Course **accreditation** to the Council for Health in Ministry of Health and Social Welfare of Republic of Srpska.

She is Associate Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli (previously named University of Naples SUN) since November 2010. She was Researcher at the Department of Psychiatry of the University of Naples SUN from 2001 to November 2010. Since 1992, is staff Psychiatrist at the Department of Psychiatry of the First Medical School of the University of Naples since 1992. Professor Mucci specialized in Psychiatry at the First Medical School of the University of Naples as well as started with her academically carrier completing her MD and PhD in Neuroscience.

Current research activities include: biological correlates of negative symptoms domains in schizophrenia, cognitive remediation in schizophrenia as well as factors influencing schizophrenia real-life functioning.

Professor Mucci is the President of the Psychoneurobiology Section of the World Psychiatric Association, Secretary of the Schizophrenia Section of the European Psychiatric Association and President of the EEG and Clinical Neuroscience Society.

She has published about 130 papers in books and scientific journals.
